



# Youth removed for child behavior problems, truancy and running away stay out of home 17 months on average


Average Length of Stay Out of Home for Youth Removed for Child Behavior Problem, Truancy and Runaway FY 2011-2015 Releases

# Majority of these youth were removed for child behavior problems



#### Average Length of Time Out of Home for DCF Removals for Child Behavior Problem, Truancy or Runaway FY 2011-2015 Releases


