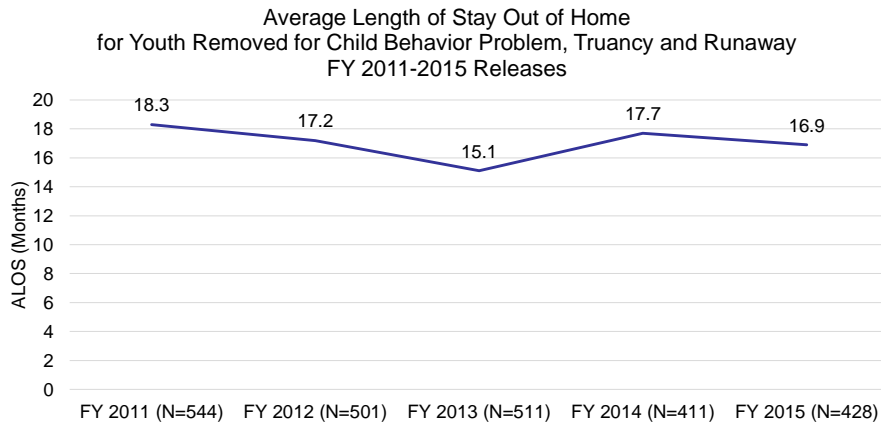

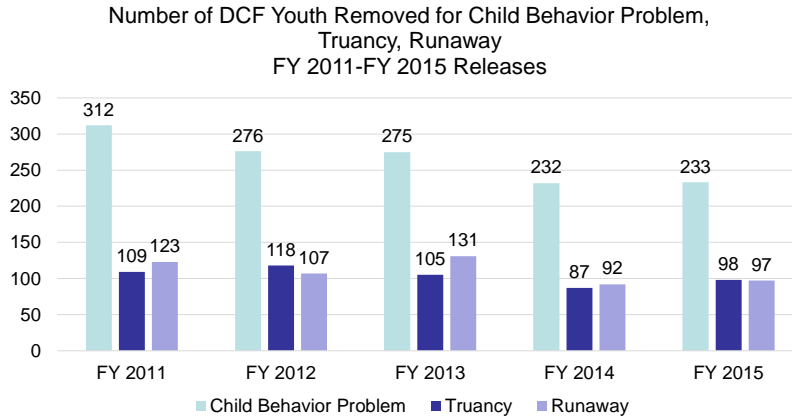
DCF Removals for Child Behavior Problem, Truancy and Runaways Out of Home Length of Stay Data

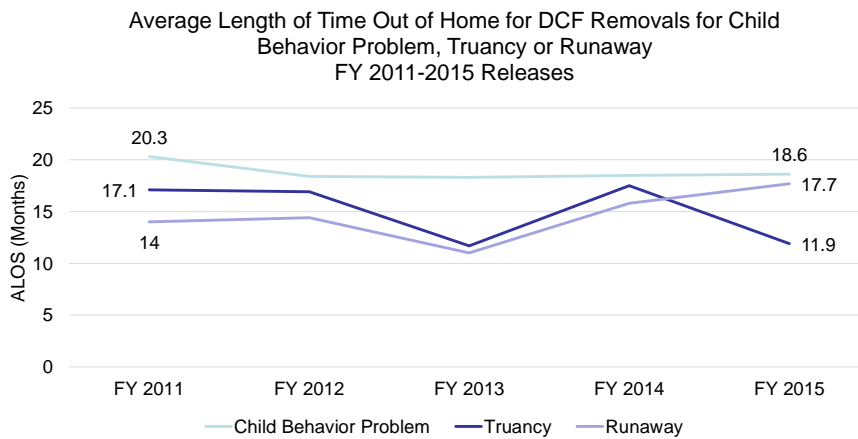
Majority of these youth were removed for child behavior problems

Youth removed for child behavior problems stay out of home longer on average than truancy or runaway removals

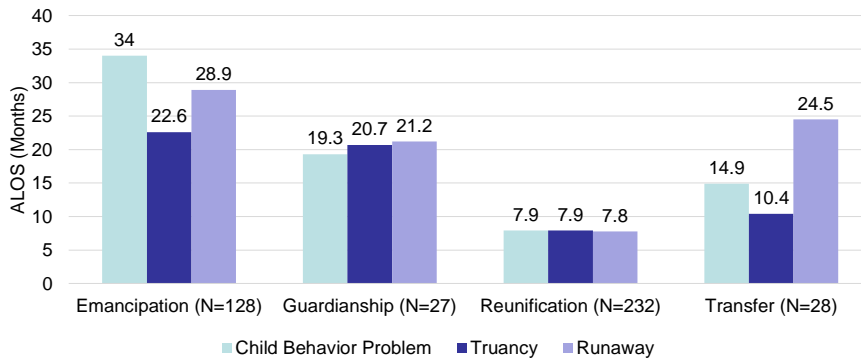
