1). **FCT-1626 – Efiling: Document Sequence Numbers**

When an e-Filing is opened in clerk review, sequential document sequence numbers will be defaulted for all e-filed documents. These will be editable in clerk review, but if the filing detail window is closed without completing processing, the numbers will be re-calculated, to avoid conflicting with sequence numbers that might have been added to the case in the meantime. Checking the ROA Only checkbox will void the document sequence number for a document. When a filing is accepted, the document sequence numbers will be transferred from the filing to the ROAs created on the case. The e-Filing file stamp for district courts has been enhanced to show document sequence numbers. Document sequence numbers created through e-filing will not be editable in the ROA window.

Customer Issues

1). **FCT-1615 – Invalid Row Error When Deleting Hearings**

User will no longer get an invalid row error when deleting the only hearing on a case.

2). **FCT-1621 – Imaging: Error when Trying to Scan a Page and Insert Into Existing ROA Document**

A new page can now be successfully scanned and inserted into an existing ROA document.

3). **FCT-1623 – FullCase Interface: Amended Charge Data Not Flowing from FullCase to FullCourt**

Amended charge data will now flow from FullCase to FullCourt.

4). **FCT-1629 Warrant could Erroneously be Created on Closed Cases**

A warning message now displays when a case is closed and an attempt is made to create either a new arrest or bench warrant.
