ROA sealed is checked

- ROA entry is sealed from public access
- ROA entry is viewable at INK
- ROA entry is viewable on e-flex to those attorneys with e-filing accounts that are an attorney of record on the case

Document sealed is checked

- Document image is sealed from public access
- Document images are not sent to INK
- Document image is viewable on e-flex to those attorneys with e-filing accounts that are an attorney of record on the case

No e-filing access is checked

- This checkbox does not impact public access at all and if ROA sealed and Document sealed are not checked, the entry will be viewable by the public, even when No e-filing access is checked.
- ROA entry is viewable at INK
- Document images are not sent to INK
- ROA entry and Document image will not appear within the case summary screen in e-flex even if the attorneys have an e-filing account and are an attorney of record on the case.

*The only way to keep an ROA entry from being viewed through INK is to seal the entire case.

*Attorneys with e-filing accounts that are an attorney of record on the case have access to sealed cases through e-flex.
